

Our aim is to provide learning provision for students who cannot access suitable mainstream education: who are disengaged, in between schools or who are temporarily excluded - with an aim to re-integrate them back in to mainstream school.

We are also a 'Quality Assured Centre': Moderated through Doncaster and Scunthorpe Local Councils. We provide a unique, therapeutic, calm, safe and nurturing environment to enable individuals to take time out, make


progress, move forward and meet their full potential. We are able to help students manage and overcome their emotional and behavioural difficulties, remove their personal barriers to learning whilst increasing their resilience.

We also work in partnership with all professionals surrounding each child and offer therapeutic support and counselling as required.





1. Our Provision



- ✓ We offer a concise and quick referral process to assess if we can meet student's needs
- ✓ We provide each student with a Dedicated Tutor and Mentor support
- ✓ We ensure that the student's learning targets and personal development goals are met by assessing and monitoring behaviour and achievements (however small) daily
- ✓ We work closely with students, parents, carers, schools and other professionals to ensure we are meeting the student's individual needs.
- ✓ We produce progress reports for each student on their progress and a final report on leaving the centre
- ✓ We support students in the transition to reintegrate to mainstream school/college/employment - where appropriate
- ✓ Our small team have accumulated over 40 years' experience working in Alternative Provision and Education
- ✓ We aim to develop students' social skills ensuring they interact positively with each other and help them to realise how they can contribute more positively to society
- ✓ We ensure that our students obtain a sense of achievement, begin to re-engage more positively with learning and achieve their full potential.
- ✓ We offer ongoing after care and door always open policy to come back and talk to us anytime.



2. Inclusive Supportive Learning & Education

We can offer a timeline to suit all students, whether that be short-term help or longer support. Every student is unique to us, and we personalise and tailor learning to each individual and their specific needs. We create a safe place that encourages students to challenge and speak with their true voice. We believe in all students' capacity for growth - whatever the level.



1 2 1 Learning - Individual Development - Growth

We can work with any time frame to suit your student but typically this involves: From short-term 6-week reintegration back into school, 12-week medium term programme or longer-term bespoke programmes of 3 months plus ongoing supported learning programme.

Core subjects support and guidance

1-2-1 learning and support to get through GCSE's or Functional Skills and support with work supplied by school/college. Working to the core GCSE or Functional Skills English and Maths curriculum – with the opportunity for students to sit their exams in Doncaster supported by Students. We also offer support for transition into employment and training schemes offering career advise as needed.

PSHE support (**personal, social, health and emotional** support) from the study centre helps children and young people to be safe, healthy and prepared for life's opportunities.

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




Our Team
